

# Take care of felt

Daily attention and frequent vacuuming are the alpha and omega when it comes to keeping products made of wool felt looking good.

It is not recommended to use a vacuum cleaner head with rotating brushes.

Best results are usually achieved if a mark is immediately removed before it has had time to dry.

Daily vacuuming removes dirt & dust before it has a chance to bind to the woolfelt product, and it removes sand and other loose material, so the product is less prone to wear.

Maintaining felt made from wool is very easy, so long as you remember the above. But one or two tips are also worth knowing:

A woolfelt product may develop what appears to be excess wool and this can give a 'wooly' surface. This is naturally due to the short wool fibers in the felt. Simply vacuum the product to remove this excess.

The sooner a stain is removed the better. Any liquids should be wiped with an absorbent cloth immediately.

- The worst dirt is removed by dabbing the stain with a clean cloth.
- Then spray the stain with lukewarm water, possibly with a mild soapy solution and dab again with a clean cloth.
- Repeat if necessary.

Also, think of your wool product as a wool sweater and treat it accordingly when cleaning, i.e. using a water and mild soap solution is ok, but rubbing on the felt is not advisable.

For stubborn stains or very dirty areas, it is recommended to have a professional cleaning company that has experience in cleaning wool felt to clean the product.
